The first tournament brought in over \$10,000 and they sold around 700 t-shirts. Over the past four years The Urban 6 Foundation has raised over \$50,000 and sold over 2,500 t-shirts to help bring awareness to the community. Todd feels that you must empower the youth in order to help find a cure for breast cancer.

There is now a board made up of seven students from various high schools which include St. Ursula Academy, Northview High School, Springfield High School and Perrysburg High School. The board helps with the planning and organizing of not only the event, but t-shirt sales as well. The board, along with the support and help from the parents and Todd, is what makes the Kickin’ It To Find The Cure tournament possible.

Todd really enjoys the whole process of the tournament. “This tournament brings awareness to the youth in a fun and competitive environment,” said Todd Strayer.
