Neighbor's dog attacks, injures Maumee woman

Maumee police are investigating a dog attack Tuesday that sent a woman to the hospital with an injured arm.

Carol Mason, 71, was attacked by her neighbor's German shepherd about 6:20 a.m. while taking her trash cans to the curb at her home in the 500 block of East Dudley Street, Detective Sgt. Jeff Siebenaler said. She was taken to the University of Toledo Medical Center, formerly the Medical College of Ohio Hospital, where no information was available.

The 9-year-old dog had no history of attacks, Sergeant Siebenaler said, and was being held in quarantine by the Lucas County dog warden.

Charges have not been filed against the owner, but Sergeant Siebenaler did not rule them out.
