COLUMBUS, Ohio - The families of two drowning victims filed two lawsuits on Friday against Hartford at the Lake apartment complex. The lawsuits describe how more than an hour passed before 5-year-old Elijah Walker was pulled from the freezing waters of the icy pond at Hartford at the Lake apartments in February. The complex is located at 2400 Shore Boulevard in Columbus. James Jenkins rushed into the water to try to save Elijah when by-standers called for help.
