

RECIPE: Katie's Buffalo Chicken Dip with Homemade Pita Chips

This is the perfect appetizer for the big game – just make sure to bring extra copies of the recipe since you'll be asked for it!

INGREDIENTS: Pita Chips

- 3 pitas, each cut into 8 wedges
- 4 Tablespoons olive oil
- 1 clove garlic, smashed
- Salt and pepper

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F and line baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Combine olive oil, garlic, salt and pepper in a small bowl. Brush over pita chips then bake for 12 to 15 minutes. Sprinkle with additional salt and pepper to taste.

INGREDIENTS: Buffalo Chicken Dip

- 2 cups shredded, cooked chicken
- 1 8oz package cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup hot sauce (like Frank's RedHot)
- ½ cup blue cheese dressing OR ranch dressing
- ½ cup crumbled blue cheese OR shredded cheddar

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350°F.



- 2. Combine all ingredients and pour into a shallow, 1-quart baking dish.
- 3. Bake for 20 minutes or until heated through. Stir and serve immediately.

Pregnant Woman Follows Doctor's THERE'S STILL Orders To Take Zofran For Nausea, TIME TO APPLY **Causes Birth Defects In Baby**

According to the National Institutes of Health, approximately 85% of all pregnant women experience morning sickness early in their pregnancy. Why is Zofran dangerous for unborn babies?

According to the FDA and multiple studies, taking Zofran while pregnant can potentially lead to a two-fold risk of serious, sometimes fatal, birth defects, including:



- Heart defects
- Cleft palates
- Kidney defects

The greatest risk to the unborn child is when the drug is taken during the first-trimester of pregnancy.

- Pain and suffering
- Medical costs
- Medical monitoring
- Loss of income
- Emotional distress and other damages

Boyk Law Investigates Medical Malpractice Claim After Woman **Dies From Undiagnosed Car Accident Injuries**

The passing of our client weeks after her car accident may have been the result of medical negligence, which is why we are investigating a medical malpractice claim on her family's behalf. Drunk Driver Strikes ATV. Leaves Massive Injuries In Its Wake

Our client was pushing a child back home on an ATV after the vehicle ran out of gas. A drunk driver slammed into them, striking the woman and throwing the little girl from the four-wheeler. The impact of the accident resulted in the amputation of both of the woman's legs and she was hospitalized for weeks in Intensive Care. The little girl was hospitalized for two days with a traumatic brain injury, a laceration to her right ear, and cuts and bruises.

Truck Strikes Car, **Throwing Driver From The** Car & Breaking His Back

A young man faced two weeks in the hospital, multiple fractures, and surgery after being ejected from his car during an accident. He and his girlfriend were struck by an industrial lawn care truck and they were hit with such force that he suffered a "burst" fracture of two vertebrae that required spinal surgery and the implant of two rods and six screws into his back. He is facing weeks of physical therapy, additional surgeries, and it will be months before he will be able to return to work.
