Boyk Law Goes After E-Cigarette Maker JUUL® For Targeting Children

The use of JUUL® and other vaping devices has reached epidemic levels, especially among teenagers and young adults. Nicotine addiction and vaping injuries among middle and high school students have been on a dramatic rise over the past few years. In response, federal and state governments are targeting vaping device manufacturers, like JUUL® Labs, for fueling this epidemic by marketing their products to adolescents.

E-cigarettes work by heating a liquid that contains concentrated nicotine and other chemicals to produce an aerosol that is inhaled into lungs. Vaping companies market

and sell nicotine liquids flavored like gummy bear, Skittles®, and cotton candy – clearly targeting children. "These companies are creating a pathway for youth nicotine addiction for profit," says Boyk Law Attorney Wes Merillat, who is pursuing federal court

actions against JUUL*. "They have deployed sophisticated tactics to reach our teenage children that has proven to be highly successful. They must be stopped and held accountable."

Use of these products has been associated with numerous adverse health effects, such as seizures, nicotine addiction, nicotine poisoning, breathing problems, behavioral and psychological problems, and other serious conditions.

CASES OF INTEREST: NOVEMBER 2019

17-Year-Old High School Senior Hit On The Side Of County Road 830

Our client, a 17-year-old high school senior, pulled to the side of the road with car trouble. His friend came to assist and pulled his vehicle behind our client's. Both our client and his friend were standing on the side of the road when another driver, traveling 55 mph, failed to keep an assured clear distance ahead and struck the parked vehicles, sending them smashing into the two young men. Our client was knocked unconscious and was taken to the trauma center at a nearby hospital where he was diagnosed with significant head injuries. This young man with a bright future was restricted from returning to school and after-school activities such as the marching band. Further, his plans to join the military and attend bootcamp the summer after graduation were halted. Our client continues treatment and has a long road to recovery.

Injured Worker Undergoes Three Surgeries After Shattering His Knee While On The Job

Our client was on the job when he stepped onto a raised metal platform to fix a broken conveyor system that had stopped moving. While he was on the raised platform, another part came at our client and knocked him to the ground. As he was still falling, our client's boot got caught in an open area of the platform and his left knee completely shattered. Our client was taken by ambulance to the hospital's trauma center and underwent immediate surgery. Since then, he has had two additional knee reconstruction surgeries. Boyk Law was retained

to help our client through the Workers' Compensation process for this terrible workplace injury.

Disabled Patron Severely Injured While Using TARTA Bus Services

Our disabled client was being transported by TARTA bus services when he was severely injured exiting the bus. Because our client was physically restricted to a motorized scooter, he required use of the lift upon entering and exiting the bus. While being lowered off the bus, the lift went awry and our client was knocked to the ground, with his motorized scooter landing on top of him. Our client was taken to the hospital with significant injuries to his knee. After a lengthy stay in the hospital, our client was facing long-term care in an out-patient facility before, sadly, he passed away.
